Summary of significant personal achievements in teaching

Dr. Trisciuzzi has achieved significant personal achievements in teaching. The students participate with great involvement in both lectures and workshops giving very positive feedback. I also receive feedback from former students who have now graduated and who write to thank me for the skills they acquired while teaching. It is also noticeable that students are increasingly requesting dissertations on various topics addressed in the classroom, such as gender stereotypes in children's literature, the importance of visual storytelling and the study of *picturebooks*, new families and changes in female figures through the lens of children's literature. Trisciuzzi offers lectures with an interdisciplinary outlook, giving the possibility to link the discipline, for example, to special pedagogy, beauty education and intercultural pedagogy.

Unfortunately, Trisciuzzi was unable to follow several students during the dissertation of their dissertations as she was on compulsory maternity leave but received several positive feedbacks from the students and the examining board.

She also received very positive feedback from students at the University of Bari for whom he gave two lectures on Children's Literature.

Maria Teresa Trisciuzzi's volume competently and originally addresses one of the fundamental themes of pedagogical reflection - the family - through the analysis of the main pages of the Classics of Children's Literature and the best proposals of contemporary fiction. In particular, through a very dense and high-quality research work that interconnects the studies on the subject in an interdisciplinary manner, the author covers a long period of time -

from the 19th century to the present day - to probe the literary representations of family lives, dwelling on moments of everyday life, learning, play, but also on violence, abandonment and childhood without a family.
