Candidates who have scored at least 12 points out of 20 will be admitted to the oral exam. Points for the oral exam: maximum 60 (discussion of the candidate's curriculum, training path, and research project). Minimum final score 60/80

Information on the oral exam	Oral exam: it will be held in English and will mainly focus on the academic qualifications, on the objectives that the candidate intends to pursue during the Ph.D. programme and on the topics covered by the research project presented. For the evaluation of the oral exam, the following aspects will be considered: clarity and linearity of presentation, argumentative ability, theoretical and methodological knowledge in the field of economics and/or political science, and congruence of study interests and research objectives with the research topics of the Ph.D. programme. For PNRR-funded thematic scholarships (Ministerial Decrees 117 and 118/2023), particular attention will be paid to the consistency between the project presented by the candidate and the illustrative sheet of the chosen topic.		
	Language: During the interview, the knowledge of the English language will be assessed, for which the minimum required level is B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages - CEFR. In the case of foreign candidates applying for PNRR-funded thematic scholarships (Ministerial Decrees 117 and 118/2023), the knowledge of the Italian language will also be assessed.
