# Compulsory documentation to be attached to the application

- work, study, and research experiences gained in the sectors covered by the Ph.D. programme
- self-assessment of the knowledge of the English language according to the Common European Framework of Reference for the knowledge of languages (this self- assessment can be produced within the curriculum presented by the candidate:
- indication of the possession of any official certificates of knowledge of the English language at level B2 or higher, issued by accredited bodies (this certificate can be attached to the CV and will be evaluated as additional documentation in the section "other titles").
- self- assessment of knowledge of foreign languages other than English, including Italian in the case of foreign candidates

#### Abstract of the Master's degree thesis.

The Abstract is to be written in English, and must not exceed 1500 words. (to be submitted also if the title has not yet been obtained, specifying the presumed date of the discussion, provided that it is dated before October 31st 2025)

#### Research project

The project has to be written in English and consist of up to 2,500 words (the bibliography is excluded from this computation), on a topic related to the thematic area "International Economic Policy Business and Governance": ". Attention will be focused in particular on:

- (a) Growth, inequalities, and transformations of economic systems, national and supranational responses to major recessions, to tensions in politics, trade and finance, to technological change and Artificial Intelligence, and to environmental challenges;
- (b) Evolution of multinational companies and SMEs, industry and the public sector, finance and work in a context of international fragmentation of production and of growing economic and political instability;
- (c) Geo-political processes and political choices of European, international, regional and national institutions for the governance of globalization and international relations.

The Project must be articulated as follows: a) state of the art; b) research objectives; c) theoretical and methodological framework; d) research design; e) expected result; (g) references.

	The selection committee will consider the completeness of information included in the CV, the quality and thematic coherence of the Master thesis and Research project, the quality of written English of the documentation uploaded, and additional certification of English Proficiency of non-mother-tongue candidates, if produced.	
	Candidates who will have scored at least <b>12</b> points out of 20 from the evaluation of qualifications will be admitted to the oral exam.	
	Points for the <b>oral test (interview)</b> : maximum <b>60</b> points (including the discussion of CV, research project, and evaluation of English language proficiency) During the oral test the following aspects will be assessed: clarity and linearity of exposition, argumentative capacity, theoretical and methodological knowledge in the context of the proposed research project, congruence of study interests and research objectives with the research themes of the doctoral programme, motivational aspects, listening comprehension and quality of spoken English will also be evaluated.	
	Minimum score to pass the oral examination: 40 points
